Your Committee has been working diligently over the last 12 months using their professionalism for the betterment of the Island and the welfare of residents.

Highlights of the year include:

Main source of income continues to be advertising in our Newsletter followed by membership to our Association and term deposit income.

Membership renewals and income from membership are down and the new committee will need to undertake a membership drive during 2018-9.

We have invited various Real Estate Agents to sponsor sunset sips so costing works out about cost neutral.

As long as these streams of income continue our basic outgoings will be covered.

Association expenditure for the year exceeded income by a few hundred dollars (after \$2630 payment from pontoon fund, term deposit interest income added to principal and \$500 withdrawn for petty cash were taken into account)

I would like to thank our advertisers and our sponsors of Sunset Sips for their support and trust our residents will support them.

Reconciled monthly statements, receipts, bank statements etc are available for perusal after the meeting.

Surplus funds are parked in a term deposit at Bendigo Bank Ettalong until required.
