**To: The President of St Hubert Island Resident Association.**

You will be aware that Council has received funding for a safety upgrade to the St Huberts Island bridge. This project is part of the Central Coast Roads Package funded by the Australian Government through the Urban Congestion Fund.

The Project will include the removal of the existing bridge railings and replacement with safety barrier mesh fencing on both sides of St Huberts Island Bridge. This will improve the safety of pedestrians and deter improper actions of some members of the public previously experienced on the St Huberts Island Bridge.

Council have engaged an appropriately qualified civil and structural engineering consultant to design the proposed safety barrier mesh fencing in accordance with guidelines and standards.

It is anticipated tenders for the supply and installation of the new safety barrier mesh fencing will be called in June-July 2020. Once tenders have been received the timing of construction can be established. The Residents Association will be further advised of the exact date of commencement of work and provided with the name and contact details of the Council Officer who will manage the contract for the work.

A typical section of the proposed safety barrier mesh fence is shown below. (Dimensions are in millimetres.)

Council would be happy for the Residents Association to distribute the information contained in this letter to its members.
