All positions on the committee will be vacant and I invite all interested members to come along and nominate for any position they would care to.


The island needs some fresh ideas, some fresh enthusiasm and now is the time to put your hand up and serve the community that we are all part of.

SEA LEVEL RISES

In reply to the president's statement in the Island News, the Coastal Residents Inc. are well aware that a portion of Brisbane Water foreshore is within the State Electorate of Terrigal, however the Association had some sound reasons for holding a public protest rally outside the electoral office of the State Member for Gosford.

- 1 The State member for Gosford was the Mayor of Gosford Council at the time councillors decided to encode S149(5) certificates of 9000 properties with the 0.9 sea level rise message.
- 2 The state member for Gosford remains to this day a councillor of Gosford Council responsible for the above matter.
- 3 The state member for Gosford is a member of the present state government who is responsible for legislative processes with the above encoding.
- 4 The current state government as did the previous Labour state government, in response to our requests for intervention, redirects Coastal Residents Inc to Gosford Council as the Authority responsible for encoding S149(5) Planning Certificates.
