Palms for the entry state ment

Existing trees in the area have been removed in readiness for the installation of the Palms and I have received the following information from Kim Radford of Gosford City Council in respect to the installation of the palms:-

“There are 8 Chinese Fan Palms (*livistonia chinensis*) palms going in - 4 each side of the road between the signage and the end of the bridge. They will be set lower down from the road level (towards the water) to allow pedestrian access but also to avoid services. The area around each palm will be retained and mulched. The palms are from Kibble Park and we are anticipating September installation as spring is the best time for transplanting.

Whilst these are not the Cabbage Tree Palms (as specified in the plan), we are using the opportunity to get 8 mature palms installed at the entry to the island.”

Some information on the palms to be installed-

“*Livistonia chinensis* - Chinese Fan Palm

The large bright green fan-shaped leaves are deeply divided into about 75 segments that droop downward to give a gracefully fountain-like aspect inspiring its common name Chinese fountain palm. These leaves may grow up to 5 ft (1.5m) in diameter and form a dense canopy on a solitary brown trunk that bleaches to gray on older specimens. trunks grow to about 18 in (46) in diameter and are wider at the base.

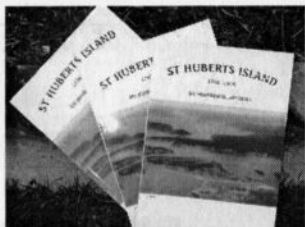
