The rate of sand loss is accelerating and is a warning of future problems. You can help by keeping boat speeds down to a "no wash".

Run the 'run-a-bouts' that the children use at a 'no-wash' speed. Foreshore maintenance for the future, prevention is better than the CURE.





Sewerage Service St Huberts Island

The sewerage service of St Huberts Island is like the island itself, unique. The system is not your average system it is a vacuum system which needs constant maintenance and supervision.

Over the Christmas period there was a need to consult with council officers in respect to this unique system and here are a few of the Do's and Don'ts for residents to ensure the system functions without too many problems:-

Do

* Ensure clear access to the vacuum chamber at all times and ensure there is adequate clearance around the vacuum chamber to remove the lid and allow work on the chamber.

* Call Council if sewage is leaking from the vacuum chamber.

* Call Council if you hear the sound of rushing air at the vent to the vacuum chamber.

Don't

* Use toilet deodorisers which hang on the inside of the toilet bowl - they frequently become dislodged and end up clogging the household vacuum chamber - it is preferred that you use the type which hangs within the cistern.

* Put tampons, sanitary pads or similar bulky items down the toilet - they clog up the household vacuum chamber - dispose of them in the rubbish bin.

* Park cars over the vacuum chamber.

* Erect gardens, rockeries, paths, driveways or other structures over the vacuum chamber.

* Place anything on the vacuum chamber lid.

* Pour fatty substances down the sink as the fat collects in the vacuum chamber and clogs it up.
