The matter of removal of broken boat ramps by Council was reported recently in some local press and despite various communications to Council I am not in a position to give any more information on the matter but your committee is always pursuing unresolved issues with Gosford Council.

Entry Statement

It was great to see the turn out for the opening of the entry statement in June when The Mayor Councillor Jim Macfadyen attended. Yes the entry statement is now a feature of the island with the finishing touches being now done to the structure for its protection. In respect to the project we must thank the generosity of residents who contributed financially and a local real estate agent who similarly donated to the cause.

We are now expecting a final account from council for only 50% of the cost. The structure was financed from members fees, the sale of glasses and the generous contribution from the production and sale of the History Book. Considerable effort was put in by residents and thanks must go to Louise Williams for the plan drawing. Hydro Blast for the protective coatings now

being applied.

Painting of Bridge Handrails

There has been considerable comment from residents about the state of painting of the bridge handrails and the matter has been the subject of numerous letters and phone calls to Gosford Council over several years.

The most recent response was from The Mayor who states:"Unfortunately, there is a limited budget for bridge maintenance work and priority is given to urgent structural repairs and routine maintenance of the over fifty (50) road and pedestrian bridges within the City of Gosford. Notwithstanding the above, the painting of the handrails on St Huberts Island Bridge will be listed for consideration of funding in the

2009/2010 Capital Works Program.

In the mean time, the condition of the handrail will be monitored and if required structural maintenance will be undertaken".
