Mooring and Pontoons

In respect to saga moorings I am informed that unauthorised moorings in the canals are to be removed by council, this has only been achieved after a lot of pressure from the committee - by the time this report is published the unauthorised moorings should have been removed.

Pontoons now are becoming more prevalent and a fund is being accumulated in council's accounts for the maintenance of the canals. The committee is keeping this matter before Gosford Council and when Brisbane Waters studies are complete I believe we will be in a position to achieve some much needed maintenance to the canals.

Also at the meeting we will give consideration to a possible change of format to a dinner meeting for the March Annual General Meeting.

Westpac Rescue Helicopter Service

On any given day someone on the Central Coast will be in need of urgent medical care and many times the fastest and most efficient way to get there is on the Westpac rescue Helicopter.

We read, hear in the news and see the helicopters frequently transporting patients to higher medical care. Whether it be a transfer from one of our regional hospitals to specialist care in Sydney, people injured in road, rural or industrial accidents, surf rescues from our beaches, assisting in fire fighting and other search and rescue emergencies.

The Central Coast is served by the benchmark Service that covers not only the Central Coast but the Hunter and Mid North Coast. Its twin engine helicopters are within minutes of all parts of the regions and since its inception in the early 1970's medical care and emergency rescue has changed dramatically.

The number of missions the Service performs in the Central Coast region continues to grow. Recent figures show that the helicopter's services are utilised on average 2 times per week and people who are transported are not required to pay.

The community owned Westpac Rescue Helicopter Service is an integral part of the health care chain in which the medical profession and the department of health need to transfer patients.

The Service operates 24 hours a day, every day of the year and it costs approximately \$8 million per annum to keep the helicopters and crews able to respond when needed. Of this, \$5 million comes from the support of the community. The remainder is contracts with the NSW Government through the Department of health and NSW Ambulance.


