

With the water restrictions in force now and you decide to top up your swimming pool with Sea water please be aware that this will increase the salt content in your swimming pool water.

Excessive salt content can damage salt water chlorinators – There were only two models that I found were able to cope with Sea Water (37000 ppm) all other models are not designed to handle high levels of salt.

Keep a close check on the salinity of your water and seek advise from your pool shop or ring Neville, 43417739 for discussion about my solution.
