IT'S MAGPIE NESTING TIME

Reduce your chances of being swooped!

Magpies are familiar to many of us and for most of the year they live quite happily with people within the urban environment. However, at breeding time magpies can become a nuisance bird as they seek to defend their territory in order to protect their young.

In the breeding season from August to October, magpies may swoop on people or pets they perceive as a threat to their nest. Swooping generally takes place for less than an 8-week period in Spring and this begins when the adult pair is nesting and finishes when the young leave the nest. Swooping magpies have been known to cause injuries and there are some simple thing that we can do to minimise this risk. If you come too close to their breeding area they may attack.

People can take the following precautions during the short period when birds are actively protecting their territory. Because they hesitate to attack if they think they are being watched, they usually swoop from behind.

Do not feed magpies or other birds. Feeding magpies may make them more aggressive.

Do not deliberately provoke or harass the birds.

Take care as injuries can occur as a result of the birds striking.

Avoid the swooping area by taking an alternative route.

Wear a large, wide brim hat and sunglasses or carry an open umbrella.

Walk out of the birds' territory immediately, but do not run.

Keep an eye on the bird as this may discourage attack.

Bike Riders

Get off your bike and walk rather than ride through the birds' territory.

Wear a helmet and sunglasses.

Fit a bike flag to your bike.

Magpies and other native birds are protected by law so if you feel a magpie is a serious menace, report it to the local National Parks and Wildlife Service office. A brief description of the wines that will be available for tasting

St Huberts Pinot Noir 2003

The 2003 St Huberts Pinot Noir is raspberry red with a subtle touch of purple in the glass. Aromas of fruit and spice develop into flavours of cherry and plum with a hint of Chinese five spice and delicate mouthfeel.

St Huberts Sauvignon Blanc 2004

The 2004 St Huberts Sauvignon Blanc is vibrant translucent yellow in the glass. Intense varietal aromas of gooseberry, tropical fruit, pineapple and passionfruit with a hint os grassiness are present on the nose. The palate offers well-balanced tropical fruit characters that are given further depth with a zesty acidity and a crisp clean finish.

St Huberts Roussanne 2004

The 2004 St Huberts Roussanne is pale straw with light green hues. Subtle spice, floral and flint aromas develop into a well-balanced palate that displays fresh orange peel and spice characters with a crisp, citrus finish.

St Huberts Sparkling 2001

The 2001 St Huberts Sparkling is soft straw in the glass with a delicate bead. Complex fruit and yeast aromas are present on the nose. These complex aromas develop on the palate supported by citrus flavours, developed creamy barrel characters and a crisp acidity.

St Huberts Cabernet Merlot 2002

Fresh garnet tones colour the glass and the nose displays the aromas of berry, leafy blackcurrant and dusty tobacco. These scents develop into soft flavours of briary fruit, earthy tones and cigar on a medium bodied palate. A backbone of spicy oak supports this elegant wine.

St Huberts Cabern uvignon 2002

The 2002 S. Huberts Cabernet Sauvignon displays aromas of leafy blackcurrant capsicum and dusty tobacco with supporting backbone of toasty oak. The full-bodied palate is well balanced with a continuation of these flavours, fine tanning and acid structure combining with a long finish.

St Huberts Late Harvest Riesling 2004

The 2004 St Huberts Late Harvest Riesling is vibrant translucent yellow in the glass. Perfumed citrus, mineral and floral notes on the nose develop into an elegant palate that displays orange blossum and ripe fruit flavours. This fruit driven wine has a good acid backbone and soft finish.

DOMESTIC SMOKE ALARMS

I used to think I would awaken if I smelt smoke in the house. WRONG. Smoke and reduced oxygen will put one into deeper sleep, with risk of death by asphyxiation. Recent multiple house fire deaths in NSW have occurred in houses without smoke alarms. Battery operated domestic smoke alarm prices start at about \$10. EVERY house should have one near the bedrooms and another outside the kitchen, with at least one on every level of the house. Most house fires start in the kitchen, with cooking the major cause. I have one smoke detector outside the bedroom connected into the back-to-base burglar alarm system. When initiated, the base operator rings the fire brigade if a phone call is not answered.

TENTIPS FOR FIRE SAFETY AT HOME

- 1. Take care in the kitchen. Never leave cooking unattended, always turn pot handles in.
- 2. Supervise children. Children need to be protected from fire, and from the potential for starting fires.
- 3. Heat your home safely. Place your heater at least one metre from flammable items such as curtains, furniture. toys and bedding.
- 4. Dispose of cigarettes safely. Wet down cigarette butts before discarding. Never smoke in bed.
- 5. Take care with electricity. Have an electrician check the electrical wiring throughout your home. Keep your home appliances in good working order.
- 6. Install a smoke alarm. Keep your smoke alarms clean, and test them regularly.
- 7. Plan your home escape. Create an escape plan and practise escaping from your home.
- 8. Use home security that lets you get out quickly. Keep a key in the dead-lock so that you can escape quickly in the event of a fire.
- 9. Check portable fire extinguishers. Check the pressure gauge on the extinguisher regularly.
- 10. Be prepared. Know which fire safety equipment to use, and know how to use it.
