

"Maritime bro ide sinks island moorings"

Gosord City Council at it's meeting December 14 2004 resolved to amend Development Control Plan (DCP0 145 (Mooring Facilities on St Huberts Island) and to seek public comment.

The main amendments to the DCP are:-

- * Removal of all reference to mooring:
- * Provide for a Positive Covenant in lieu of a Caveat where consent is issued for the installation of a pontoon:

The amendment to the plan where there is the removal of all reference to moorings is unacceptable in that it prohibits the installation of moorings in the canals an activity which the island residents have enjoyed for the thirty years of existence of St Huberts Island and this prohibition I believe will seriously devalue properties.

It is overdue for the Mayor and councillors to take serious action in this matter, and I call upon all residents of St Huberts Island particularly all residents of waterfront and canal front properties to thoroughly research this matter to unite and fight Gosford City Council to preserve the usage of the canals for boating purposely by the making of submissions to Gosford City Council on the proposed amendments to the DCP 145 prior to the closing date of 18th March 2005.

Owners of canal front properties have a right to use the waterway which adjoins their property as you have done since the island was developed. If you don't act now it will be too late and the benefit of the provision of a mooring will be lost for ever. Even if you are not a boatie person think of the value of your investment, the banning of moorings will seriously devalue your property.

From the residents surveyed in 1996 on the question "In your opinion, if moorings were not permitted, would your property value Dramatically decrease? Decrease? Not change? Increase? Dramatically increase? the most popular answer by far was that property values would either Dramatically Decrease or Decrease.

Canal front owners contribute 32% more in residential rates 2004/2005 to Gosford City Council.

Gosford City Council's Environmental Department have initiated this action to amend the plan after the closing time for submissions and it appears without public knowledge called for submission from NSW Maritime. From the history of the public debate on the boating facilities of the canals of St Huberts Island Waterways have not shown any interest in the matter over the past decade. One can only surmise how they came to be involved in the process well after the public debate was closed. But the activity has caused considerable heartache to your committee who have pursued the matter with the greatest of vigor over the past decade only to be taken out at the final hurdle from a player never seen before in the debate.

The submission now sought from NSW Maritime seems to be a deliberate obstruction to the wishes of the residents of the island and the finalisation of the approval of boating facilities on the waterways of St Huberts Island.
