## President's Report September 2004

Gosford Council always seem to be on the wrong end of my comments but it needs to be said that we as an association get a great deal of support from Gosford City Council maintenance staff particularly from Woy Woy depot. One area of support is collection of debris from the canal foreshores, I know of quite a few residents who have taken to cleaning the canal beaches and have the bagged material removed by Gosford council staff particular thanks must go to Rick Hodges and his band of merry men from that depot-again well done Rick and staff of Gosford Council.

Although I get a certain amount of complaint from residents about the lack of street sweeping on the island I note that the mechanical sweeper is a regular attendee on the island it is a rare month that the sweeper is not on an island round. Peter Rugless from council's Woy Woy depot has been instrumental in organising of this service - well done Peter and staff of Gosford Council.

As a committee we now have a formal approval of Gosford City Council to proceed with the entry statement which has been long on the drawing board. A committee has been set up to investigate the costs, funding and possible donations which can be made to bring this important project to a reality.

By now most residents will have received their rate notices for the year and have almost recovered from the shock of the amount of increase applied to the island properties.

This has come about by the system applied to local government ( g and a new set of valuations for the entire area of Gosford City. The mix or distribution of the rate burden has been changed by virtue of the new valuations, there is not much we can do about it but we as an association will be making representation to council to endeavor to get better value for the rate dollar we pay.

In respect to boating in the canals and waterways of the island a Public Meeting was held by Gosford City Council on 8 July 2004 to consider the matter of reclassification of the canals. The meeting was well attended and the matters were well aired despite the lack of input from council officers. At that meeting there was an overwhelming support for the reclassification and now hopefully Gosford Council will be proceeding to finalise the Local Environmental Plan necessary for the formalising of boating in the canals and waterways of the island.
