In response to complaints received about speeding on the Island, a speed enforcement was conducted recently on Helmsman Boulevard. Using a hand held "LIDAR" (light, detection and ranging) state of the art laser speed checking device, a Gosford Highway Patrol - Brisbane Water Local Area Command officer recorded four speeding infringements in just half an hour and issued on the spot fines to the offending motorists.

Residents' Association Membership




