

SAFE BOATING Attention Boat & Jet Ski Owners

Recent deaths and injuries that are caused by water craft accidents are preventable.

The registered owner of a craft has a lawful responsibility to abide by and observe the speed and other rules set down by the Matritime Services. The owner is responsible for the behaviour of any person allowed to be in control of the craft. Firstly any person in charge must be licenced.

Towing of children on tubes or boards at speed is very dangerous and has resulted in death.

Craft 5.5 mtr or more in length must be registered. Craft with a motor over 6hp should be registered and the number displayed.

"No Wash" signs are clearly displayed. All St Huberts canals are no wash restricted tp prevent erosion and damage to the seawalls, Maximum speed is 4 Knotts, no towing of water skiers.

Be aware of the safety rules, life jackets etc. Check your craft for fuel, anchors, bucket and lanyard for bailing and oars and rowlocks.

Before going to sea or a few hours cruise let your neighbours Know, contact Coastal Patrol on 4325 7929 Report dangerous boating behaviour to Maritime Services.

Unlicenced persons particularly children in charge of a vessel is a serious offence, is irresponsible and dangerous. Alcohol and boating is not a good mix.

VACUUM SEWERAGE SYSTEM INSTRUCTIONS

DO

- * Ensure clear access to the vacuum chamber at all times and ensure there is adequate clearance around the vacuum chamber to remove the lid and allow work on the chamber.
- * Call Council if sewerage is leaking from the vacuum chamber.
- * Call Council if you hear the sound of rushing air at the vent to a vacuum chamber.

DON'T

- * Use toilet deodorisers which hang on the inside of the toilet bowl they frequently become dislodged and end up clogging the household vacuum chamber it is preferred that you use the type that hangs inside the cistern.
- * Put tampons, sanitary pads or similar bulky items down the toilet they clog up the household vacuum chamber dispose of these items in the rubbish bin.
- * Park cars over the vacuum chamber.
- * Erect gardens, rockeries, paths, driveways or other structures over the vacuum chamber.
- * Place anything on the vacuum lid.
- * Pour fatty substances down the sink as the fat collects in the vacuum chamber and clogs it up.

And then, out of the blue, with no warning, in February 1992 aged just 40, with 3 young boys (aged 8 to 3) our lives were turned upside down when I suffered a massive brain haemorrhage caused by a bursting aneurism which left me paralysed on my left side and being told I'd never walk again.



Needless to say this brought about a paradigm shift to our family life worsened by the treatment of the afore mentioned toy company I was still working for at this time - they stopped paying me, sent someone around to pick up my company car and basically shattered my world even further! They put me on the scrap heap & underestimated what a tough old gal I was and how much amazing strength and support I'd get from my family and friends.

So, after my experiences of working with too many companies I lovingly referred to as "Negativity Incorporated" (even getting the sack from one) I came the final realisation that I had to be in control of my own earning capacity and be my own boss.



So on the advice of my Doctor and with the continued support of my 'boys', in 1999 I turned my hobby of ceramics into my first business "Gail's Gallery" - a studio I ran from our Beecroft home very successfully until transferring it to St Huberts Island in 2003, changing its name to "Ab. Fab. Ceramics" and here my business has continued to grow, as has my skill as a ceramic artist - I'm not going to bore you with tedious details about this ceramics journey and the growth of a business that I'm

passionate about (and actually quite good at) except to say this business continues to grow as I share my love of ceramics with fantastic student (aka friends) and happy customers.

But even though I don't recall ever "killing any chinamen - life still had a few more surprises in store for me. 2010 whilst in England visiting one of our boys & his fiancé, a fall saw my poor old left leg broken in 2 places with a

foot that was turned 180 degrees the wrong way, an extended stay in hospital there with bolts and plates in my ankle before finally returning home.

2011 was spent excitedly planning a trip to South Africa for the wedding of our eldest son. Just a month before we're due to head off, a call back after a routine mammogram came up with an unexpected diagnosis - a small but aggressive cancer in my left breast - all I could think of was our wedding of the century and that nothing could be allowed to stop me going to that - I did make it to the wedding

although bouncing around in a jeep on wildlife safaris after a double mastectomy occasionally proved a challenge!



2014 - just recently saw the unexpected return of this beast, so back onto the chemo/radiotherapy roundabout I go AND even though some of my friends reckon I actually must have killed a whole tribe of chinamen - I'm still here despite at least 2 incidents that could have killed me - I'm not ready to leave just yet - there's still much to do. My only fear is trucks - my doctor reckons - with my strength, it'll be a Mac truck that gets me.

There's absolutely no doubt in my mind that a pos outlook is the secret to surviving all things thrown at us as w through this wonderful thing called life!

Growing old is mandatory but growing up is a matter of choic hey-let's all make the best of it whilst we still can!
