Final design for St Huberts Island Bridge Safety Barrier Upgrade

Thank you to those who provided their feedback on the proposed design options for the St Huberts Island Bridge Safety Barrier Upgrade project.

Following feedback received, Council staff have analysed the results from the latest consultation. These findings have been used to finalise the concept design and initiate development of the detailed design for tender and construction. Based on the community preference, and engineering assessment, a decision has been made to proceed with Option C - Tensile mesh design with triangular posts and tapered ends (refer attachment 1 for copy of Option C).

This project remains funded by the Australian Government through the \$86.5 million Central Coast Roads Package. Construction on this project is forecast to commence in April 2022, weather and any unforeseen circumstances permitting.
